

James River Advisory Council Stewards of the River Awards

The Stewards of the River Awards recognize outstanding community members who make measurable, positive impacts through their roles as leaders, community partners, guardians and spokespersons on behalf of the river, as communicators of the JRAC mission and vision, as storytellers of the James River's history and as educators who raise public awareness about the river. JRAC strives to network with organizations and individuals who fill these roles through their common interest in the James River.

JRAC's Vision

A healthy, beautiful, economically vital and accessible James River that is cared for by a diverse and engaged community that acts on its behalf

Criteria

Community Partnership Award

The Community Partnership Award is presented to individuals or organizations who work actively to promote partnerships within the James River watershed community. This person/organization communicates, provides support and collaborates with colleagues in partnering organizations that advance the needs of the James River and the James River Advisory Council.

Guardian Award

The Guardian Award is presented to individuals who strive to protect the James River and its resources for all citizens living within the James River watershed. This person promotes the care and respect of the river through actions and leadership and is a great influence on other citizens to do the same.

Communication Award

The Communication Award is presented to individuals who are effective in their communication on behalf of the James River and the James River Advisory Council. They are known to speak on behalf of the river to the community, legislators, businesses, localities, and the media in an effort to increase public awareness of the James River and the James River Advisory Council.

Historical Values Award

The Historical Values Award is presented to individuals who celebrate the unique history of the James River. This person researches, discovers and shares the stories of the lives and time line surrounding the James River to promote its distinction.

Education Award

The Education Award is presented to individuals who work to spread the appreciation of the James River through the children of the watershed. This person uses the James River to teach local ecology, history, water quality, teambuilding, self-awareness, confidence and community involvement.

Leadership Awards*

The Leadership Award is presented to individuals who have served in leadership roles in James River Advisory Council and whose tenure has ended or is ending. This award is presented in appreciation for years of service to the organization through guidance and direction. *Internal for JRAC executive leadership
